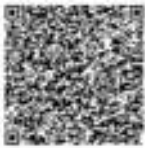
JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 27.01.2024 Section 21 of the NDPS Act (Section 29 of the NDPS Act Added later on) registered at P.S. City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 26.04.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 26.04.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 26.04.2024 is made absolute.



However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
