As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.2,70,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced be paid to appellant No.1-Sukhdeep Kaur Wd/o Sher Singh, for & on behalf of both the appellants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to United India Insurance Company and Oriental Insurance Company as the learned tribunal has fastened the liability of both the Insurance Companies in the ratio of 50:50, to deposit two cheques in the sum of Rs.1,35,000/- each (Rs.2,70,000/- in total) favouring appellant No.1-Sukhdeep Kaur Wd/o Sher Singh, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
