1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action on the written application-cum-complaint dated 10.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner against respondents No.5 to 10 and decide the same.
2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, submits that veracity of the allegations levelled by the petitioner were thoroughly investigated by the investigating agency and on the basis of opinion rendered by the Board of Doctors, allegations made by the petitioner are found to be false. The investigation was further verified by the

senior officer and no substance was found in the same.

3. In view of status report filed by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Zira, District Ferozepur, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to invoke the alternative remedy as available to her, in accordance with law.

4. The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
