1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that due to the technical glitch, the petitioner could not submit his application form for all the posts qua which he was eligible to compete and he had given two representations first on 07.02.2024 and then in pursuance to the notice of the respondents dated 10.02.2024, which representation was at Diary No. A535 dated 13.02.2024 but while declaring the result, the said plea of the petitioner that he is eligible for the post other than the one mentioned while filling up the online application form, has not been considered by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while issuing the admit card, the petitioner was made eligible for all the posts in Group 22 as advertised vide Advertisement No.3/2023 dated 07.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) but now, his result has not been declared in those very group though, a candidate lower in merit has already been allowed to proceed further in the selection process.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the representations dated 07.02.2024 and 13.02.2024, the details of which have been given in paragraph 18 of the writ petition, are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representations by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representations dated 07.02.2024 and 13.02.2024 have been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the said representations are still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, appropriate order on the said representations will be passed within a period of four weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the said representations, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will also be released to him otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
