1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 27.10.2022 passed in CWP-26539-2015.
2. Compliance report dated 18.12.2023 by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar Meena, IAS, Director General, State Transport, Haryana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that as per para 4 of the report, the respondents have given notional promotion to Randhir Singh Inspector (Retd.), husband of the petitioner, to the post of Chief Inspector w.e.f. 06.07.2001, the date from which Partap Singh, Chief Inspector, Retd. was promoted and the arrears of the revision pension would be paid after obtaining the necessary approval of the appropriate authority.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
