AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Devender and Shyam have filed petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0127 dated 12.04.2024, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 452 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar, Haryana (Annexure P-1).

2. As per the facts, FIR was registered on the statement of Anil Kumar regarding the occurrence which took place on 12.04.2024 at about 07:00 PM. Both petitioners were granted *interim* bail on 25.04.2024.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners argued that both petitioners have joined investigation and they are not required for any other purpose.

4. Learned counsel representing the State on instructions given by ASI Rajbir Singh, No. 172/Fatehabad confirmed that petitioners have

joined investigation and they are not required for further investigation.



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5. Considering these facts, no custodial interrogation of petitioners is required. Therefore, *interim* bail already granted in favour of petitioners – Devender and Shyam vide order dated 25.04.2024 stands confirmed, subject to conditions as enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition is accordingly allowed.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
