1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ, order or direction quashing the impugned order dated 16.06.2008 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No. 3, whereby the election of the Gram Panchayat to which the petitioner belongs, have been stayed.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that since much time has lapsed, thus, the present petition in all probability has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present petition be disposed of at this stage, and liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the same, in case any cause survives.
