The petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. seeking a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to get release the detainee i.e. his wife Ravina Kumari from the illegal custody of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. In compliance of order dated 24.04.2024, report from the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fazilka along with statement of the alleged detainee has been received.
