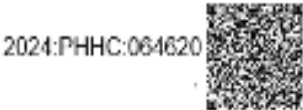

VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to supply the information as directed by respondent no.2 vide order dated 09.10.2023 (Annexure P-6) and regarding which an application dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) has been filed by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the second statutory appeal filed by the petitioner was disposed of vide order dated 09.10.2023 in the following terms:-

“6. Hence, directions are hereby given to the respondent PIO to supply the required information demanded at point no.01, 02 and 07 (only number of complaints pending or decided) to the appellant within fifteen days from today under intimation to the Commission.



7. *With the above-announced directions, the instant appeal case is announced as disposed of and closed.*
 Copies of the orders be sent to the parties.”

It is submitted that even information on point 01, 02 and 07 has not been supplied till date and for the said purpose, the application dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) has been filed before the Punjab State Information Commission. It is further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to consider and decide the said application dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-7), as expeditiously as possible.

3. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to consider and decide the application dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-7), in accordance with law, after hearing all the parties concerned, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 6 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the present order.
