Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been given due opportunity to appear in the written examination as full time required to attempt the paper was not extended to the petitioner hence, the petitioner could not answer all the questions and had the enough time been given to the petitioner to answer the questions, the petitioner would have cleared the written examination.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 08.04.2024 (Annexure P/6) , which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction be issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, representation dated 08.04.2024 (Annexure P/6) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
