1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner competed in the Category No. 181 for the post of Executive Assistant (Procurement) and though, as per her own calculation of marks, she has secured 50.7 marks, whereas the last selected candidate for the said post have 49.7 marks but still, the petitioner has not been declared successful, which act of the respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-15 but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.



3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated NIL (Annexure P-15) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be given for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
