Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking issuance of directions to respondents to release the capital subsidy amounting to Rs. 81,000/- for 5KWP SPV Power Plant installed at the residence of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents contends that the case of the petitioner has already been processed and the requisite subsidy shall be released to the petitioner within a period of four weeks.

Since the respondents have admitted the claim of the petitioner and given a statement before this Court, the capital subsidy claimed above shall be released within a period of 04 weeks, no further directions are required to be issued. The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of on the statement of respondents to release the capital subsidy within a period of 04 weeks from today. Needless to mention that in the event the above said capital subsidy is not released within the above said period, the petitioner shall be entitled to interest @ 6% per annum from the date of the writ petition till actual disbursement.
