1. At the outset, learned State counsel has submitted on instructions that the petitioner has secured 144 marks in the written examination and she was directed to be provisionally interviewed. He further submitted that in the interview, the petitioner has secured 11 marks and in total, she has secured 155 marks, whereas the last selected candidate has secured 164 marks and the person who was kept in the waiting list has secured 161 marks and therefore, nothing would survive in the present writ petition.
