1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to get the investigation of FIR No. 34 dated 15.04.2023 registered under Sections 323, 450, 354, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No. 5, Jalandhar, concluded from senior IPS Officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous as Investigation Agency has already concluded the investigation and submitted the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate on 09.01.2024.

3. Learned counsel for private respondents submits that grounds taken in the present petition are matter of trial, which are to be decided only after adducing evidence and it would be a moot point to be determined by the

learned trial Court on the basis of evidence adduced by the parties.



4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present eption and seeks liberty to avail the alternative remedy as may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
6. Pending CRM(s), if any, are also disposed of accordingly.
