1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondents for defying the order dated 17.05.2023, passed by this Court in CWP 10610 of 2023.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has been complied with and speaking order dated 24.04.2024 has been passed. Copy of order dated 24.04.2024, produced by counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. Registry is directed to tag the copy of order dated 24.04.2024, produced by counsel for the respondents with the file after scanning the same, at an appropriate place.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, in accordance with law.
