1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 05.10.2023 passed in CWP-22341-2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the principal amount has already been paid. Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted for claiming of interest on the delayed payment.
3. Dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, it would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
