Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking termination of pregnancy of minor victim who has become pregnant on account of offence of rape committed upon her and case bearing FIR No. 60 dated 12.04.2024, under Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 has also been registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Pursuant to the order dated 25.04.2024, passed by this Court, a medical report has been received from the Medical Board of Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER),

Chandigarh”, wherein it is informed that the patient is medically fit for termination of pregnancy (MTP).

Legal Aid Counsel has further informed that the termination of pregnancy has already been carried out and she has already been discharged.

In view of the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition. The same is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage.

Needless to mention that the District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar shall consider the claim of the victim for grant of compensation under the applicable Victim Compensation Scheme.
