Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of impugned order dated 25.03.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide which prayer of the petitioner has been declined with reference to application under Section 216 of Cr.P.C. for alteration/modification of the charge in case FIR No. 21 dated 21.04.2017 registered under Sections 306, 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station GRP, Pathankot.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajit Singh submits that prosecution has examined all the prosecution witnesses.
