Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that now the matter stands compromised between the parties and that respondent No.2/complainant is having no objection if the present petition is allowed and impugned order dated 10.6.2020 (Annexure P-34) is set aside and the cancellation report be accepted in light of settlement deed dated 4.1.2024 and he produced copy of the settlement deed which is taken on record.

2. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 has not disputed the aforesaid settlement deed dated 4.1.2024 and further submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties and the complainant is having no objection if the impugned order is set aside and the cancellation report submitted by the police dated 4.5.2020 (Annexure P-33) is accepted and respondent No.2 will not pursue the protest petition; that,

however, the parties be directed to remain bound by the terms and

conditions of the aforesaid settlement deed and the present petition be disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

3. State counsel made statement that the present petition be disposed of in light of the aforesaid statements made by the counsel for the parties.

4. In light of above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed in light of no objection pleaded by the complainant/respondent No.2 and consequently, the impugned order dated 10.6.2020 (Annexure P-34) is hereby set aside and the parties are to remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement deed dated 4.1.2024 and the aforesaid statements made by counsel for the parties.
