1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the Post Gradation Certificate issued to the petitioner on 11.03.2020 (Annexure P-8) is not being taken into account for considering the claim of the petitioner for various Group D posts as advertised vide Advertisement No.1 of 2023 dated 30.05.2023 (Annexure P-4).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by not taking into consideration the Sports Gradation Certificate of the petitioner (Annexure P-8), prejudice is being caused to the petitioner which the respondents are under obligation to redress.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 08.03.2024 (Annexure P-9) which is

still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the representation dated 08.03.2024 (Annexure P-9) be allowed to be supplemented with certain facts which have come to the notice of the petitioner after the filing of the same.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 08.03.2024 (Annexure P-9) along with any supplementary representation filed within a period of one week from today, has been received in the office of concerned authorities, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of six weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
