1. The instant Contempt Petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for not complying with the order dated 12.10.2018 passed in CWP No.20270 of 2014 (Annexure P-1).

2. For detailed reasons, see separate Judgement of even date passed in CWP No.20270 of 2014 titled as **'Gobinder Singh versus Managing Director PEPSU Road Transport and others'** vide which the claim of the petitioner *qua* his entitlement of back wages for the period he remained out of service of the Corporation has not been found sustainable and the same has been dismissed, therefore, nothing further survives in the present contempt petition and the same is also deserved to be dismissed, as petitioner has already been paid a cheque of Rs.35,000/- on account of CPF in compliance to the order dated 12.10.2018, which has duly been recorded in the order dated 22.07.2019, and the calculation sheet justifying the aforesaid amount was duly handed over to the counsel for the petitioner in the Court, as recorded in the order dated 27.01.2020, which learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute/controvert for the last four years. In view of the above no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
