1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.0280 dated 22.09.2023 registered under Sections 406/419/420/467/468/471/474 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but his grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali)-respondent No.3 by way of representation dated 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-5), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a

direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali)-
respondent No.3 to depute a senior officer to look into the representation
dated 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same by passing an
appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months
from today.
