Present **second** petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.188, dated 19.05.2021 (P-1), under Sections 302, 323, 324, 120-B and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station, Sadar Kanina, District Mahendergarh.

2. Dr. Jaiveer Singh Malik, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the petitioner and filed his power of attorney with no objection from previous counsel, which is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel has produced custody certificate dated 01.08.2024 and the same is taken on record.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that instead of pressing the bail on merits, he would be satisfied in case learned

6. Superintendent of Police, Mohindergarh shall ensure that official prosecution witnesses are produced well in time and Superintendent District Jail, Narnaul shall also make all possible efforts for production of accused before learned trial Court.
