1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that her services are sought to be terminated vide show cause notice dated 02.04.2019 (Annexure P-10) on the ground that she has refused to perform the election duty.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner never refused any duty to be performed rather requested that only the duty which she could perform apart from taking care of the children while working as an Anganwari may be given to her, hence, the respondents be directed not to terminate the services of the petitioner and the petitioner is already continuing in service even as of now.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents does not dispute that the petitioner is still in working but submits that the petitioner was asked to



perform certain duties during the election and on the instigation of the Union, the petitioner tried to wriggle out.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

5. Once, there is no complaint with regard to the work and conduct of the petitioner even after filing of the present petition and the petitioner is continuing in service, the respondents are directed to allow the petitioner to continue in service subject to her satisfactory work and conduct hereinafter. In case, petitioner mis-conduct herself, appropriate action be taken in accordance with law.

6. The present petition is disposed of with the direction that the petitioner will be allowed to continue in service subject to the above mentioned terms and conditions.

7. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
