1. By way of the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.48 dated 20.04.2014 (Annexure P-1) registered for offences punishable under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B of IPC at Police Station Payal District Ludhiana Rural and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 23.12.2015 (Annexure P-5).

2. In the considered opinion of this Court, respondent No.3 having raised the issue with respect to compromise and the petitioners

and respondent No.2 alleging that he is acting upon a forged power of attorney.

3. This issue cannot be decided while exercising Section 482 Cr.P.C. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail alternate remedies in accordance with the law.

4. Allowed as prayed for.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
