1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short ‘Cr.P.C.’) for quashing of supplementary challan under Section 173 (8) Cr.P.C. dated 04.07.2023 filed in FIR No.54 dated 30.03.2023 under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short ‘IPC’), registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom.
2. Per contra, learned State counsel, assisted by Mr. Nikhil Ghai, Advocate and Mr. Gurjas Gill, Advocate for the accused, at the outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition, as impugned challan under Section

173 (8) Cr.P.C. has not been accepted by learned trial Court and even the charges have been framed.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
