1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 06.11.2006 (Annexure P-23) vide which respondent no.2 has been illegally promoted to the post of Chief Engineer and impugned final seniority list dated 06.09.2006 (Annexure P-19) with a further prayer that respondent no.1 be directed to promote the petitioner as Superintending Engineer w.e.f. 30.08.2003 i.e the date on which he completes the requisite experience of 7 years.

2. Learned State counsel submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner and respondent No.2 have already retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause of action still survives.
