RITU TAGORE, J.

1. This revision petition has been filed by the petitioner with a prayer to direct the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana to fast track the trial in Civil Suit bearing CS/1647/2019 titled as ‘Karanveer Singh vs. Bhupinder Kaur etc.’ (Annexure P-1).
2. Given the limited prayer, the issuance of notice to the respondents is dispensed with.
3. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and with his able assistance, have gone through the paper-book.
4. A perusal of the *zimini* order 07.03.2019 (Annexure P-3 colly.) indicates that the above-mentioned suit was instituted by the respondents (plaintiffs before the learned trial Court) against the petitioner (defendant before the trial Court), for a decree of permanent injunction, restraining the petitioner, her family members, friends, attorneys, relatives etc. from interfering, or causing any interference, or dispossessing the respondents from the suit land, or alienating, mortgaging or dealing with the suit property in any manner, as detailed in the plaint (Annexure P-1).



5. The perusal of various *zimini* orders (Annexure P-3 colly.) indicates that proceedings in the suit are ongoing, but progress of the suit is moving at a snail’s pace. Despite affording the plaintiff more than 18 opportunities and more than five years having elapsed, the suit is still at the stage of evidence of the plaintiffs.
6. It is to be noted that concept of the ‘right to speedy trial’ focuses on expeditious case resolution to enhance the efficacy and credibility of judiciary.
7. In view of the above and limited prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner, learned trial Court is directed to decide the suit aforementioned within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
8. Needless to mention, parties to the suit shall assist the learned trial Court in expeditious disposal of the case.
9. In view of the above, this revision Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
10. Pending applications, if any, also stands disposed of accordingly.
