1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the show cause notice dated 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-7).
2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that the present writ petition is premature inasmuch as only show cause notice dated 09.04.2024 has been issued in the present case and as per the said show cause notice, opportunity has been given to the petitioner to file reply within 15 days of the receipt of the said notice and the petitioner without filing the reply has filed the present writ petition.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the said objection raised, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present

writ petition with liberty to file a reply to the show cause notice and has prayed that in case the petitioner files a reply within a period of 10 days from today, same be considered before passing the final order.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a reply to the show cause notice dated 09.04.2024 within a period of 10 days from today and in case the said reply is filed within a period of 10 days from today, then the competent authority of respondent No.1-State would consider the same before passing the final order.
