1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India praying for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that after filing the present petition, the parties have compromised the matter and prays for withdrawal of the present petition.
3. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the same is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioners are at liberty to approach the authorities, in case, any fresh threat perception arises.
4. It is made clear that filing or pendency of this petition or any order/direction passed in this petition shall not be an *alibi* or defence to the petitioners, in case, they are found involved in any illegal activity and the respondent-Authorities shall take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
