1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of a direction upon the official respondent to take legal action on a complaint by lodging FIR against the accused persons.

2. What surfaced upon perusal of the instant petition as well as the reply that infact the petitioner has availed the alternate remedy and filed a complaint before the the learned Illaqa Magistrate concerned with a request for registration of FIR, under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. but that request was not accepted and the learned Illaqa Magistrate concerned has proceeded to take cognizance of the complaint as a private complaint, which has caused grievance to the petitioner and he also filed a statutory revision, which was also dismissed by the learned Appellate Court concerned.

3. Since the petitioner has already availed all the alternate

remedies, therefore, no further order is required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is, hereby, **closed**. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner that in case he has any grievance left against the order passed by the learned revisional Court, he can challenge the same by filing an appropriate motion.
