1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 12 and 14 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for disobeying orders dated 04.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) intentionally and knowingly passed by the Debt Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh by which respondent No. 2 miserably failed to adhere to the undertaking given before the Presiding Officer.
2. At the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition with liberty to avail any other alternate remedy in accordance with law.
3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
