1. This is an application under Section 151 CPC for an early hearing of the main petition, which is pending adjudication for 01.08.2024.
2. In view of the grounds mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. The main petition is preponed from 01.08.2024 to today itself and taken on Board for hearing.

**COCP-1452-2024**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 10.05.2023 passed in CWP-15610-2016.
2. Respondent No.1-Vastla Gupta, IPS, SSP, Kapurthala and respondent No.2-Ankur Gupta, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, are present in the Court today.
3. Counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order dated 10.05.2023 passed in CWP-15610-2016 has since been complied

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with and demand draft No.275119 dated 03.05.2024, amounting to Rs.50,000/- has been handed over to the petitioner. Necessary order qua release of the amount of the retiral benefits to which the petitioner is entitled, have already been issued to the Treasury Officer, Kapurthala. However, the pension could not be released to the petitioner because he was not having the requisite qualifying service for the same. Therefore, speaking order was passed in that regard, which the petitioner has already challenged separately vide CWP-10804-2024.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.

6. Personal appearance of the respondents, who are present in the Court today, are dispensed with.

**CM-10993-CII-2024**

1. This is an application under Section 151 CPC for recalling the order dated 29.04.2024.

2. In view of the grounds mentioned in the application and in view of the fact that the main petition has been decided, the order dated 29.04.2024 qua stoppage of salary of both the respondents, is withdrawn, and consequently, they are entitled to the salary w.e.f. the original due date.
