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MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J. (ORAL)

By filing the instant revision-petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners-landlords have sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of direction to the Rent Controller, Amritsar, to decide *Eviction Petition bearing No.149 of 2018* titled as ‘*Gurjit Singh and another vs. Rajinder Kumar @ Billu and another*’ expeditiously and preferably in a time-bound manner, while averring that the above-referred Petition had been filed in April, 2018 and has not yet been decided.

2. However, at the time of assisting the Court at the preliminary stage in the present revision-petition, learned counsel for the petitioners has restricted his prayer to the issuance of the direction to the Rent Controller to decide the afore-mentioned Eviction Petition at the earliest possible.

3. Keeping in view the above-discussed limited prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioners and also the fact that the afore-said

Eviction Petition is pending adjudication for the last six years and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, the revision-petition in hand is, hereby, disposed of with direction to the Rent Controller concerned to conclude the proceedings and decide the Eviction Petition under reference, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
