By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer is made to quash FIR No.0095 dated 13.07.2019 registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib under Sections 420, 461, 468, 469, 470, 471 & 120-B of the IPC and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

However before this Court, limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners is to direct the trial Court to expedite the trial. Learned counsel submits that charges in this case were framed on 08.04.2022. It is further informed by him that there are five accused in the case, all of whom are appearing before the Court regularly and that there are 26 witnesses cited by the prosecution but not even a single witness has been examined so far.
