The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for challenging the order dated 03.08.2019 (Annexure P-4) whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person in case FIR No.48 dated 10.05.2019 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act and 13 PTPR Act, P.S. Navi Baradari, Jalandhar.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Similar was the situation on the last two dates of actual hearing.

The Counsel for the State submits that the petitioner is a proclaimed offender in 03 other cases and is otherwise a accused in 12 other cases.

In view of the antecedents and conduct of the petitioner I find no merit in the present petition and the same stands dismissed.
