1. This is the first petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.107 dated 06.04.2024 under Sections 353/332/506/186 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Civil Line Sonipat, District Sonipat (Annexure P-1).

2. Vide order dated 30.04.2024 this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation. The same is reproduced as under:-

“Apprehending his arrest in FIR No.107 dated 06.04.2024, registered for offences punishable under Sections 353, 332, 506 and 186 of IPC at Police Station Civil Line Sonipat, District Sonipat, the petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail.

Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated despite the fact that he was in possession of all the documents showing that he was owner of the motorcycle.

Notice of motion for 17.07.2024.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer. As and when called, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 30.04.2024 petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.
4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.
5. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 30.04.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.
6. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
