1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to surrender and seek regular bail from the Court concerned where the trial is going on, as an offence under Section 138 of N.I. Act is bailable.

In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court concerned at S.B.S. Nagar, within next 10 days and to seek grant of regular bail. In case any such bail application is filed within 10 days from today, the same shall be disposed in accordance with law on the same very day, keeping in view the fact that the offence punishable under Section 138 of N.I. Act is a bailable offence.
