1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-15734-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-15734-2023 has been complied with and necessary order dated 01.08.2024 has been passed.
