This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0075, dated 29.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).
In compliance of the order dated 01.05.2024 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court within a period of two weeks, for recording of their statements with regard to compromise. However, as per report of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, none of the parties had appeared to record their statements.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners as well as respondents No.2 and 3. It seems that the petitioners are not interested to pursue the present petition. This Court has left with no other option but to dismiss the present petition.
