HARPREET SINGH BRAR J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 73, dated 17.02.2009 registered under Sections 406/498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No. 2, Jullunder along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 26.08.2015 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. The following order was passed on 07.12.2015:

“Notice of motion for 18.02.2016.

In the meantime, parties are directed to appear before the trial Court and the trial Court, after recording statements of the complainant/victims, shall send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise along with copies of the statements.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has already been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and**

another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC Online SC 834 and Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63 and Full Bench of this Court in Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 73, dated 17.02.2009 registered under Sections 406/498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No. 2, Jullunder and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioner.
