After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners intend to file a representation with the authorities concerned for the grant of appointment to the post in question against the EBPG category as the similarly situated employees have already been granted the said benefit despite their being an interim order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioners giving details that despite there being an interim order, the posts under the EBPG category are being filled up, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an

appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of said representation and in case, after the decision, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioners, the same will be extended to them otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioners will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file an appropriate representation with the authority concerned.

Ordered accordingly.
