**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.31 dated 07.04.2024 under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

2. On 07.05.2024, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.05.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Satnam Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on



further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. On a pointed query put to the learned State counsel, he on instructions has informed the Court that the petitioner has clean antecedents and is not involved in any other criminal case.

6. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 07.05.2024 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./Section 482(2) BNSS. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to him.
