By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for setting aside the order dated 17.07.2017 (Annexure P-9) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana in Criminal Complaint No. COMI/13578/2014 dated 05.11.2014, titled as “Rakesh Dogra vs. Neeraj Satija etc.”, vide which, the pre-charge evidence of the petitioner was closed.
