1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of impugned order dated 06.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed in application bearing CRM No.38 having registration date 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) for restoration of appeal bearing CRA No.99/2018 titled as 'Unnash Khan Vs. Ruksina and others' (Annexure P-2) whereby, the application was dismissed arbitrarily.

2. In view of the settled law pronounced by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Kunappareddy Vs. Kunappareddy Swarna Kumari (2016) 11 SCC 774***, Full Bench of Madras High Court in ***Arul Daniel and others Vs. Suganya, 2022 SCC Online Mad 5435*** and by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ***Jaspal Kaur alias Pinki and others Vs. State of Punjab and others in CRM-M-19553-2023*** decided on 24.04.2023, the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 cannot be invoked to challenge proceedings emerging out of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to invoke alternative appropriate remedy on the same cause of action in accordance with law for redressal of grievances raised in the present petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
