1. A status report, dated 13.11.2024 by way of an affidavit of Sh. Tushar Gupta, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, has already been filed by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner.
