SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE(Oral)

This order shall dispose of the aforementioned two writ petitions as common issue is involved therein. For the sake of brevity, facts have been extracted from CWP-11466-2022.

2. The present petition has been filed praying for quashing the impugned communication dated 17.05.2022 (Annexure p-8) issued by the respondent-University declining to nominate its expert for the purpose of making recommendations for selection to the various faculty positions in

the petitioner-Institute.

3. After taking cognizance and issuing notice, reply has been filed by the State of Haryana which *inter alia* reveals that a policy decision has been taken by the State Govt. not to grant any N.O.C to any further educational institutes imparting education for B.Ed. Course. It is submitted that decision has been taken to prevent unscrupulous mushrooming of B.Ed. Colleges in the State which led to a situation where large number of seats are vacant.

4. In view of the aforesaid policy decision taken by the State of Haryana vide Annexure R-1, the cause raised in these petitions has become infructuous and both the petitions stand disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

All the pending application(s) also stand disposed of.
