The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 30.04.2001 vide which the petitioner has been ordered to be retired from service and to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to allow him to continue till the age of 60 years i.e. the age of superannuation and to pay the salary and all consequential benefits upto the age of 60 years.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has unfortunately died.

3. Perusal of the case file shows that the LRs of the deceased-petitioner have not been brought on record.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the LRs of the deceased-petitioner to revive the same, in case any cause of action still survives.
