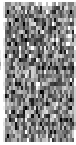

Prayer in this petition is *inter alia* for staying operation of demand notice dated 11.04.2019 (Annexure P-3) and notice dated 02.07.2019 (Annexure P-4) under Section 13(4) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (for short SARFAESI Act).

2. Learned counsel for respondent-Bank submits that account of the petitioner-Society has been settled and closed.

3. There is no representation on behalf of petitioners.

4. Be that as it may, in view of categorical statement by learned counsel for respondent-Bank, there is no justification for continuance of present proceedings.

5. Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous. Liberty is granted to petitioners to file appropriate application within four weeks in case incorrect facts have been placed before us.
