1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 18.12.2023 passed in LPA-2044-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 18.12.2023 passed in LPA-2044-2023 has been complied with and pension has already been revised and necessary payment are being paid to the petitioner. Some more benefits are being calculated and necessary payment regarding that shall also be paid to the petitioner in due course.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
